COVID-19 updates from the Polish government

The situation related to COVID-19 in Poland is stabilized, but the epidemic continues and therefore not all restrictions have been lifted yet. **Latest updates from July 25**:

Less social distance

- ✓ Distance limit for streets and open spaces is reduced to 1.5 metres.
- ✓ Distance limit is reduced to 2.5 metres (from 4 metres) and the limit of 150 participants is lifted for conferences, fairs, exhibitions.
- ✓ There is no more "skip a seat" rule for indoors art and entertainment events (cinemas, theaters, gyms).

Masks


- ✓ Covering your mouth and nose is obligatory in open spaces, when you cannot keep the distance of 1.5 metres away from others, as well as indoors e.g. in shops or public transport.
- ✓ Exceptions and other obligations can be found <u>here</u>.

Boarders

- ✓ Poland has restored full border traffic within the internal borders of the EU (and you do not have to quarantine).
- ✓ NEW! The prohibition on flights does not apply to aircrafts taking off from airports located in:
 - member states of the European Free Trade Agreement (EFTA)
 - Switzerland or an EU Member State (except Sweden and Portugal).
